With every shirt, came a new order; with every new order, I made a new friend; until I and those around me found new opportunities to spread the Gospel.

I created new designs, bolder expressions of faith, invested in better equipment to make each product more sustainable and higher quality. A movement, called to action by the Gospel, spread like wildfire and revived believers, as well as confronted the secular world with the power of Christ: all from one hand-pressed T-shirt.

From those humble beginnings, TRAVCO has spread around the globe, representing Jesus Christ in **34 states** as well as in **4 different countries**. As this company grew and reached a wider audience, I had a choice between automating the process or working harder, longer hours. So I worked harder and longer, pressing every shirt, every long-sleeve, every product myself and putting heart into every order.

Jesus never asked for more than was necessary, never was unsatisfied with his work, even if only a single person witnessed what he had accomplished. And so I put in every effort I can muster, all the love that I have been given, back into this company so that you can spread the love God has for all of us. God has given me this light that I can give it back to you, so that, in turn, you can give it to the world.
